# Preparation Course on GCSE Exam in Chinese

(A course co-organized by HKCS CHEER and HKCS KTVTC)

**Objectives: To get participants ready to take the GCSE Exam in Chinese to be held in June 2011**

**Date: 15<sup>th</sup> Dec 2010 – 7<sup>th</sup> May 2011  
(Every Wednesday and Saturday)**

**Time: Wednesday Night at 7:30-9:30pm (2hrs)  
Saturday Afternoon at 3 – 6 pm (3 hrs)**

**Total course hours: 91 hours**

**Venue: HKCS Kwun Tong Vocational Training Centre (KTVTC)  
(G/F, 5 Tsui Ping Road, Kwun Tong, Kln.)**

**Target: All ethnic minorities aged 15 or above who have learnt Chinese (speak, read and write) and want to take the GCSE Exam in Chinese in June 2011**

**\*Participants must pass the entry test set by the course organizer**

**Quota: 15 persons (First-come first-serve)**

**Fee: FREE OF CHARGE (Not include exam fee payable to the examination authority and purchase of supplementary reference books)**

- Exam fee for entry to June 2011 exam is around \$1200
- Participants who have 90% attendance and pass in the GCSE exam in Chinese in June 2011 are eligible to apply for "CHEER Scholarship"
- \* Grade C and Grade D in Chinese Language in GCSE is accepted as comparable to Level 3 and Level 2 in Chinese Language respectively in HKCEE for civil service appointment
