Appendix 01 - Notes to Participant

1. Participations in activities and programmes is restricted to persons whose names are on the relevant application forms.
2. In the case of cancellation, which may be due to bad weather and unforeseeable problems, CHEER will contact you as soon as possible.
3. In the case of cancellation owing to staffing issues, CHEER will notify you alternate arrangement as soon as possible.
4. Participants should cooperate with staff and tutors by following their instructions.
5. You should take care of your personal belongings at all times. CHEER will not take responsibility for loss or damages to your belongings.
6. If you have an accident or are being harassed while participating in CHEER's activities and programmes, you should inform our staff immediately.

Note 1: If the activities and programme will be held outside for a period of time, staff should decide whether to continue the activities and programme or not according to the safety of the participant's.

Note 2: Staff will decide whether the activities and programmes are held in a safe condition or not according to criteria such as program venue and nature. Outdoor activities and programmes and water sports will be cancelled. Indoor activities and programmes shall proceed as planned unless it is unsafe to travel to the venue in which case the activity/ programme will be cancelled.

Note 3: Staff will decide whether the activities and programmes will continue according to the weather conditions and will notify participant as soon as possible..

Note 4: Staff will regularly check weather news from the Hong Kong Observatory and advise service users to leave the Centre.

Note 5: The Centre will be closed. Centre's staff will notify all persons in the Centre as soon as the Hong Kong Observatory made an announcement of issuing Black Rainstorm Signal or No. 8 Cyclone Signal and arrange for them to leave the Centre safely before the signals are hoisted.

Note 6: When the No. 8 Signal is cancelled or lowered, the Centre will re-open within two hours. But if the Centre is due to close within 3 hours after the typhoon signal is lowered, the Centre shall remain closed.

Note 7: When the cold or very hot weather warning is issued during outdoor activities and programmes are taking place, staff will make a decision to continue or suspend the activity or programme.

Note 8: Staff will notify all participants in the case of cancellation due to High Air Pollution Index .

Note 9: If its decreased to No.1/Amber rainstorm signals from higher signals before 3 hours or more of the planned program time, program should resume to proceed except special notification is made to participants.
