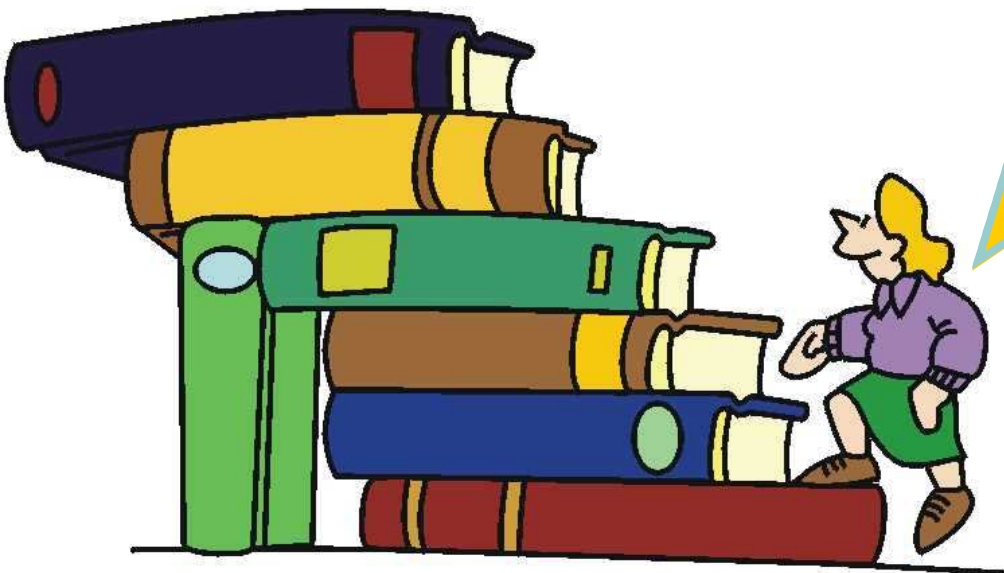

# Introduction:

Centre for Harmony and Enhancement of Ethnic Minority Residents (CHEER) is one of the support service centres funded by the Constitutional and Mainland Affairs Bureau (CMAB) of HKSAR Government to provide accessible services to ethnic minorities in Hong Kong. Through the provision of services ranging from tangible interpreting service to multi-dimensional programmes, CHEER aims at facilitating ethnic minority people to have a cheerful and harmonious life in the society.

CHEER scholarship aims at offering grant (**maximum amount \$2,000 for each awardees**) to non-Chinese residents in advancing their skills, knowledge and qualification beneficial to their adjustment and personal development in Hong Kong.

The grant can be used for studying full-time and part-time educational, vocational and interest courses(#) to pursue personal growth. The grant shall be given in the form of reimbursement. (*1st reimbursement:70% of the approved grant; 2nd reimbursement: 30% of the approved grant*)

# Application criteria:

Non-Chinese residents of Hong Kong aged 15 or above.

# Application procedures:

1. Fill in the application form (Available at CHEER's website : [www.hkcscheer.net](http://www.hkcscheer.net) or in the CHEER centre at **G/F, 5 Tsui Ping Road, Kwun Tong, Kowloon**)
2. Return the application form together with the necessary documents to HKCS CHEER by post or in person on or before **14 MARCH 2011**
3. Selected applicants will be invited for an interview.

# Selection Criteria:

- Previous and current participation in programmes for personal growth.
- Previous and current participation in programmes in serving others.
- Motivation to learn new skills and knowledge.
- Motivation to make contribution to the society.
- A concrete plan in using the grant for personal growth.

14 March 2011:	Deadline of Application
17-27 March 2011:	Interview selected applicants
31 March 2011:	Announcement of result to successful applicants
On or before 30 May 2011:	Confirmation of applied courses and 1st reimbursement of grant
On or before 31 July 2011:	Completion of courses and 2nd reimbursement of grant
