

MENTOR @ HOME SCHEME 2023-2024





Since 2009, Mentor@Home has been providing face-to-face, one-to-one, home-based language training to ethnic minorities residents who are unable to attend formal language classes. In the past 13 years, over 409 ethnic minority mentees have been helped by 305 mentors.

WHO DO WE HELP?

Our mentees are ethnic minority residents who are unable to attend Chinese/English courses conducted in classroom settings in the community. They might be persons with physical disability, housewives fully-occupied by household duties or senior residents with low mobility, etc. WHO CAN BE A MENTEE?

To be ELIGIBLE to enroll as a mentee, you SHOULD BE:

- Ethnic minority (non-Chinese) residents aged 6 or above,
- Have barrier in using Chinese and/or English,
- Have difficulty to attend classroom training (as assessed by our staff in interview) or New arrivals reside in Hong Kong for 6 or less years,

 - Agree to having mentors and staff to pay visit to your home, and
 - Willing to commit 15-hour language training with mentor



To be ELIGIBLE to enroll as a mentor, you MUST BE:

- Aged 16 or above,
- Secondary 5 education level or above,
- Appreciate cultural diversity, and
- Willing to provide at least 15-hour one-to-one and home-based language training to needed ethnic minority
