[Notes: (i) Candidate will be required to pass a trade test (except those candidates who have completed a full apprenticeship in vehicle engineering). (ii) Preference will be given to candidates who have relevant working experience in vehicle engineering field.]
Note:	<ol> <li>All applicants for civil service jobs will be assessed on their knowledge of the Basic Law and the National Security Law. A pass result in the Basic Law and National Security Law Test is an entry requirement for all civil service jobs. Only those candidates who have passed the Basic Law and National Security Law Test will be considered for appointment. For candidates who have not taken the Basic Law and National Security Law Test or have not attained a pass result in the Basic Law and National Security Law Test at the time of application, they may still apply for the job and arrangements will be made for them to take the relevant Basic Law and National Security Law Test during the recruitment process.</li> <li>Successful candidates may be posted to other departments and may be required to (a) perform emergency/stand-by/on-call duties and work irregular hours; (b) work in remote areas or harsh conditions; (c) drive a departmental vehicle under the self-drive scheme; and (d) wear uniform/protective clothing.</li> </ol>
Duties:	A Senior Artisan (Vehicle) is mainly deployed on supervising and directing the work of a team of minor staff in the operation/maintenance of mechanical plants (including vehicles) and equipment; and performing operation/maintenance duties independently, including maintenance work which requires higher skills.
Terms of Appointment:	A new recruit will normally be appointed on civil service probationary terms for three years. Upon passage of probation bar, he/she may be considered for appointment on the prevailing permanent terms.
